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Observations: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Environment / climate / biophysical subjects are a bit scarce, stressing this topics / matters is highly recommended; - Many workshops and syllabus tend to urban or similar studies, fact also visible in the student performance projects handed in. It is recommended to tackle and explore further topics as rural, tourism development and impact, natural areas etc. - Consider a development on 5 (3+2) years - integrated (compulsory) professional master - followed by a 2 years research / scientific master and 4 years PhD studies instead of 4+3+4 could be beneficial in the frame of international exchanges - As it is difficult to accurately calculate the time and ECTS credits devoted to Landscape Design (Studio), from the 137 ECTS credits stated for Design & Planning Theories, Methodologies, and Applications we highly recommend that a clear stated 50% of time / activities and 50% of ECTS should be for studio work / project - The internships should be valued through the allocation of ECTS credits - It is recommended to ensure mandatory courses related to art and drawing (only elective for the moment). Furthermore, landscape architecture courses should be present in the elective courses (most of them are rather in architecture or other fields for the moment). - A stronger accent should be put on natural environment / sciences and natural dynamics as for now is almost only on man-made and built environments.
